- pediatric plastic and reconstructive surgery addressing hemangioma, vascular anomalies, skin and soft tissue lesions, syndactyly, polydactyly, gynecomastia, facial trauma reconstruction, burn and scar reconstruction, prominent ears

Denis was born with Apert syndrome, a condition characterized by abnormal growth of the skull and face. When he was 2, Denis' family traveled to Beaumont Children's Hospital from Russia for a consultation with Dr. Chaiyasate, who successfully performed a cranial vault reconstruction and monobloc craniofacial distraction advancement aided by the latest 3-D imaging technology.

Charlotte was left with a severely deformed nose and mouth after a raccoon attacked her when she was an infant. At age 10, she found Dr. Chaiyasate. Over several months, he performed multiple surgeries to repair the damage. Charlotte has a number of procedures remaining, but the results have already restored her confidence and quality of life tremendously.
